The Greater Lawrence Community Partnerships for Children Program (GLCPC) covers the cities/towns of Lawrence, Methuen, Andover and North Andover.

Services through the GLCPC include supportive services such as parent trainings and workshops, parent home visiting through the Parent Child Home Program, play groups through the Joint Family Support Program and GLCPC Family Network program, professional development and higher education coursework for child care staff, focusing on various topics such as behavior management, Sensory Integration, music, math, science, Scientifically Based Reading Research (SBRR), early emergent literacy, etc. Mental Health consultation services and assistance and support for NAEYC/NAFCC/COA accreditation, including Leadership & Advocacy.

All participating centers are, or are in the process of becoming accredited through the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), The National Association for Family Child Care (NAFCC), or The Council on Accreditation (COA). Grant funds (50%) can be used to purchase NAEYC/NAFCC/COA materials, application packages, assessor visits, training, and technical assistance for programs.

In close collaboration with Early Literacy, Parent Child Home Program (PCHP), Joint Family Support Program (JFSP), GLCPC Family Network, Public School Systems, Adult Learning Centers, Early Childhood Collaborative, Early Intervention, Family Services, Inc., Pathways to Family Success, School Age programs, recreational programs, MSPCC, Libraries, etc. insures delivery of services from birth to adulthood.

## EEC Centralized Waitlist



The EEC centralized waitlist is the first step for income eligible families applying for EEC financial assistance (scholarships for Preschool).

### **The following information is needed to be placed on the EEC Centralized Waitlist for infant, toddler, preschool school ages, and after school care**

1. Parent(s) Name, Date of Birth, and Social Security Number
2. Child(ren) Name, Date of Birth, and Social Security Number
3. Family's Address
4. Number in the Household
5. Monthly Gross Income (bring pay stubs)
6. Disabilities (parent/child)  
Primary Language of the Household

**Bring the information to us and we will add your name to the waitlist.**
